

Main activities by the Task Force on Emission Inventories and Projections

Draft Workplan for 2011-2012

- (a) Encourage increased levels of national support for the activities of the Task Force;
- (b) Undertake tasks in the maintenance and improvement plan (MIP) for the *EMEP/EEA Air Pollutant Emissions Inventory Guidebook* (Guidebook), as support allows;
- (c) Form an Ad Hoc group to provide specific support to WGSR on Flexibility Mechanisms associated with the revision to the Gothenburg Protocol. This Group will update and extend the existing TFEIP paper on Flexibility Mechanisms, for submission to the EMEP SB in 2011;
- (d) Undertake an assessment of the current knowledge on Black Carbon, and provide support to the TFHTAP as resources allow. The TFEIP Co-Chairs will seek contributions to a short report, for submission to the EMEP SB in 2011;
- (e) Continue to support the stage 2 and 3 review processes by liaising with CEIP;
- (f) Continue to liaise with parties not submitting data or IIRs, to facilitate more complete reporting;
- (g) Liaise with the EMEP SB Chair regarding possible actions to address the lack of progress in reporting from countries in Eastern Europe, Caucasus and Central Asia (ECCA);
- (h) Review the extent to which the forthcoming Russian version of the Guidebook is used by ECCA countries;
- (i) Hold its twenty-fifth meeting, jointly with the European Environment Information and Observation Network (EIONET) network of the European Environment Agency (EEA), scheduled for Spring 2012. Venue to be decided.
